**GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PEACH TOURNAMENT**

1. Please print off The Rules of the Tournament (on website) that were given to the Coaches, for your perusal, **PLEASE READ THEM!!**
2. Field Marshall's will be at all Fields, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The Field Marshall's have the game sheets for each game. Before each game go to Field Marshall and get your Game Sheet – it will be filled out for you. Just put Referee and Assistants' names down, and **PUT THE SCORE IN!** And any red/yellow offences. Hand the game sheet back to the Field Marshall after the game (even if you are running late with the next game!). The Field Marshall has to call in the score to Marcia at Headquarters (Kings Park) immediately after the game.
3. If it is hot, please ask the coaches before the game whether they want a one-minute water break in the middle of each half. If they do, inform them that you do not add this time taken out to the half. (Players do not leave the field for this water break). We have to maintain our schedule!!!!!!
4. The only time you should add time on to the half is if a major delay has occurred due to a serious injury. Please advise the coaches of this before the game.
5. Please inform the coaches before the game that you will only accept substitutions at the Center Line. Have the subs kneeling down – have the players come off the field and then allow the substitutions on the field. Please inform the Coach on how you want to treat subs (either when they have possession of the ball or at your discretion).
6. Coaches/ players on one side of the field, spectators on other side of field. **PLEASE ENFORCE !**
7. If you are not supplied with assistant referees for a game, teams have been advised that if this is the case you will be asking each team to provide a Clublineman. Please inform the Clublinesman that they will only have to call the ball in or out. No offside calls or foul calls.
8. Please inform the coaches to inform their parents that water bottles are not to be thrown on the field to the players during the game.
9. There will only be overtime and/or shoot-outs on Sunday during the semi-final/final games. Please double check all Sunday games with the Field Marshall as to whether or not over-time must occur due to a tie.
10. Please do not put up with any abuse. If a Coach/parent is misbehaving, stop the game and give a warning to the Coach stating that if he continues, you will be forced to stop the game and ask him/her to leave the field. If it is a parent causing the problem, ask the Coach to speak to the spectator, and again, if the spectator/parent persists, ask them to leave the field and don't start the game until they have left. If this happens, it is your discretion how much time can be added to the half. Also write up a brief report on the game sheet. If the Coach does not leave the field when you asked him/her – call the game. The Coaches will be informed that in this case the game will be called a forfeit (no matter how little time is left in the game) and the score will reflect a 1-0 score.
11. Field Marshall's will have bottled water for free use by the Officials.
12. Of course, it is not necessary for me to say, please dress in uniform, no sunglasses or hats.
13. All Officials will be paid on Sunday at 3:30 pm at Kings Park. If you do not want to wait for your cheques, please advise Alison Reigh at 492 7862 during the week-end to make other arrangements.
