The goal of the 2010 SOYSA fundraiser is to raise \$100,000 towards the new extension of the Adidas multi-plex. Each plaque will be sold for only \$100, community members are welcomed to purchase as many plaques as they wish.

Concept for the installation of the plaques:

The two rhomboid shapes will form a few different dimensions, the soccer ball hexagon shape (white) is the shape when 12 plaques are combined. The combination of 3 plaques will give a 3D illusion to the overall design. As well the inner shape is a star, as an athlete we all dream of becoming our very best in our sport.

The materials used are copper (will change colour over time - blue-green), iron (or red plaque) and stainless steel that won't rust or change colour. The red or iron plaque is used to represent energy and the obvious - the colour of our Canadian Flag. The copper or green represents the earth, the fields or playing area for sports, and during its colour change, illustrating the changing of sports and its earthy/foundational goals to help children in their growth as sportsman and sportswoman. The silver or blue represents the purity, the water that nourishes an athlete. As the colour doesn't change it represents the steadiness, the nature of competitive sports, reflecting that sportsmanship in a team sport, and in times of extreme energy a team or athlete steps up to the challenge, as the boxes represents a stairway, a stepping stone, the plaques each bearing a name in honor of our environmental footsteps. The three colours also is a symbol of two teams and the referee.

This pattern of shapes/plaques is a perspective (literally & figuratively) and challenges the viewer as in competitive sports.

The plaques will be placed on a wall inside the new sports complex by SOYSA and on this wall of plaques will be a painted image of a sports theme and inside the theme will be the plaques.

In summary, this concept is a universal design, simplicity in nature, but complex matrix covers many metaphors describing and symbolizing the nature in sports.

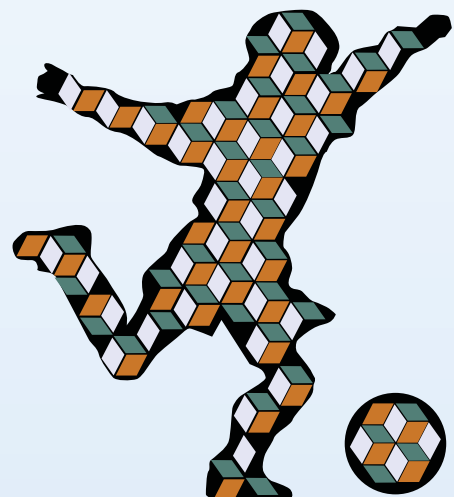
